Year 7 Scholarships at Crescendo-HELP International School

The Board of Directors of Crescendo-HELP International School (CHIS) is pleased to announce the launch of their Scholarship Programme for students completing Primary 6 to join us for the academic year September 2018 – July 2019.

Students considering joining Crescendo-HELP International School may wish to apply for a Scholarship to assist them financially through their studies. Scholarships will be awarded to students who show excellence in their approach to studies and those who have specific skills and talents to a high level such as in music, arts and sports.

The Principal's Scholarships will be 100% waiving of the published fees; the Board Scholarships will receive a 50% reduction on the published fees. These Scholarships cover the School Fees only, other fees and costs such as books, uniform, and etc. are still payable. The Scholarships will remain with the successful student throughout their continued studies at CHIS and for as long as the standards they were accepted for, continue to be met: until the completion of Year 11.

If those standards fall, a meeting will be held and a period of improvement agreed as shown in the Support Plan so as to allow the student to recover his/her purpose. If his/her standards do not improve, the Scholarship Committee has the right to withdraw the Scholarship support at the end of the term in which the Support Plan took place.

If you would like to be considered for a Principal's Scholarship Award or a Board Scholarship then please complete the form attached and bring or send it to Crescendo-HELP International School for the attention of the Principal before 2nd July 2018, with supporting materials.

The CHIS Scholarship Committee will review entries and invite short-listed applicants for an interview. Interviews for the applicants will be held starting 10th July, 2018. It should be understood that the decision of the Principal of CHIS in the determining of the awards whether offered or not, is final.

We look forward to welcoming more excellent students from our community. Scholarships are primarily for new students joining CHIS but some may be awarded to excellent internal candidates.
